### Scripture Focus

But I want you to be without **care**. He who is unmarried cares for the things of the Lord—how he may please the Lord. But he who is married cares about the things of the world—how he may please *his* wife. There is a difference between a wife and a virgin. Free from anxiety

Free from care

fixed or fastened so as not to give way or  
become loose  
Safe , Unthreatened

Seek to promote GODS interests

provide for GOD

to be anxious ABOUT GOD

Be troubled with cares OF GOD

Holy translates to the Greek word

**ἅγία | agios**

a saint

most holy thing

*to be scared, pure, consecrated, morally blameless*

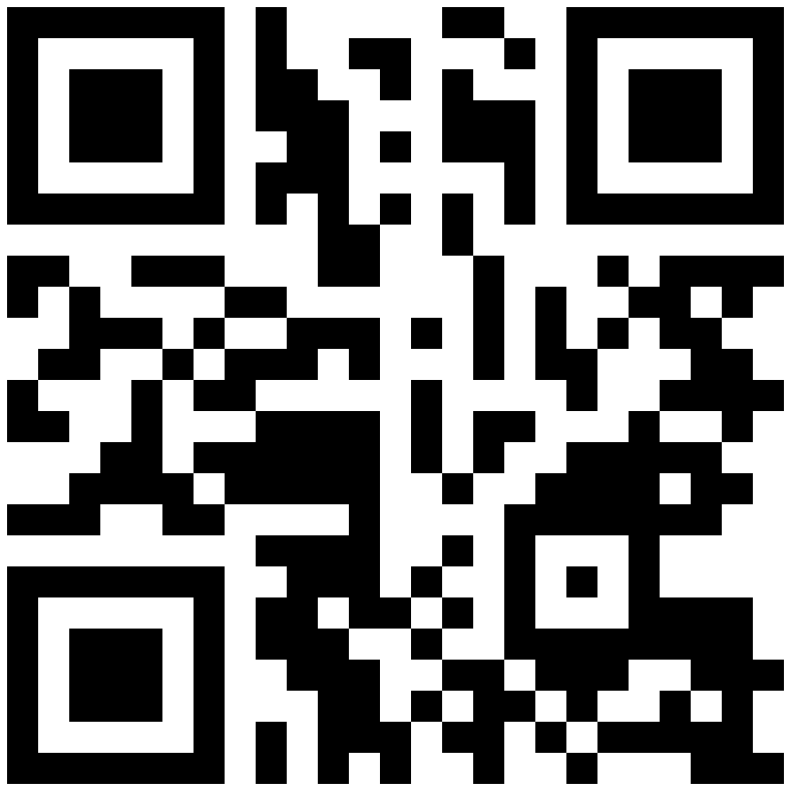
